**Finale of statewide youth music competition broadcasts live on PBS Wisconsin and Wisconsin Public Radio March 6**

PBS Wisconsin and Wisconsin Public Radio (WPR) will present the final round of the Madison Symphony Orchestra's Bolz Young Artist Competition, featuring four of Wisconsin's most talented high school musicians, in ***Wisconsin Young Artists Compete: The Final Forte***.

The Bolz Young Artist Competition is a highly regarded statewide competition in which Wisconsin's young musicians compete for scholarships and the exciting opportunity to perform as soloists with the Madison Symphony Orchestra at Overture Hall.
